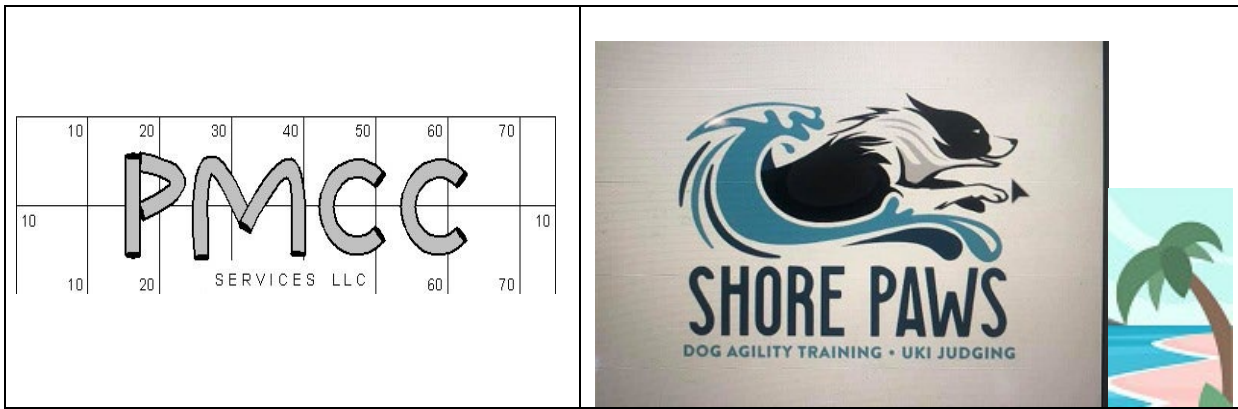

**The Paradise Cup is comprised of INTERNATIONAL JUMPERS,
STANDARD and 'speedstakes' COURSES**

designed by Anders Virtanen of Sweden

To be Judged by Kelly Ely, UKI Judge

This is an Unsanctioned International-style Agility Event held in a 90x130 ring.

Also this day: The Novice / Young Dog Jumps and Tunnels Tournament - see page 2

Entry Fees: International: \$60 (up to 3 runs); Novice: \$35 (2 runs), payable to PMCC Services LLC - see entry form, last page. A dog may enter one tournament or the other, but not both.

HERE IS THE Paradise Cup (INTERNATIONAL EVENT) INFORMATION. For the Novice Tournament, please see further down page 2.

The International style tournament will be comprised of a Jumpers course, then an Agility Course. A jumps and tunnels ('speedstakes') course last. Results of the Final Course determine the overall winners. Novice tournament courses will follow each of the first two Paradise classes, then that event is done for the day. Note that a Novice-level dog may enter this Tournament instead of the other.

PRIZES FOR: Top Scores in each height and more! Details in the Final confirmation!

Prizes will be cash (more than your entry fee!) and possibly also bling specially designed for this event.

DOGS must be at least 18 months old to participate. Run at your normal jump height - honor system!
There is no minimum level of accomplishment in any agility organization require to compete here.

Scoring: time plus faults per round. (Missed contact, knocked bar, refusal/runout: 5 faults); A wrong-course E will only be 15 faults; however an omitted obstacle will be an NQing F.

Jump heights of 4,8,12,16, 20, 22, 24. Teeter and Dog walk have 36" contacts.

There will be no table in any of the courses. A-Frame height 5'6 except 5'3 for 4,8,12

How to qualify for Paradise Cup finals:

-Overall Height Winner of each round automatically goes to the final.

-And after the first two rounds, the next 4 best scores -per height- also make the finals.

Running any round FEO/NFC disqualifies you from qualifying for finals but you are welcome to come to the event to train as there is no entry limit. NFC gets course time. "Fix and Go" allowed and you can qualify for final if you win the class in the other round..

Electronic timing down to 1/1000th second provided by PMCC

The Novice/Young Dog Jumps & Tunnels Tournament Info.

"Young dog tournament " minimum age 12 months, top end 2 years UNLESS the dog is not competing at a higher level than novice in any of UKI/AKC/NADAC, etc/ starters in USDAA,

There will be two courses comprised of just jumps and tunnels. One Novice course will run after the first International Round; the other Novice course will run after the second International Round. While the Paradise Cup final round is being built, scoring will calculate the winner(s) of the Novice Tournament - cash and possibly also specially designed bling.

JUMP HEIGHTS - choose an appropriate jump height for your pup, 4 inches and up. Measuring will be available.

ENTRY FEE is \$35 (late entry \$45, late=enter after closing date of Feb 21). You may train.

Scoring: time plus faults per round. (Knocked bar, refusal/runout: 5 faults); an E (wrong course) is only a 15-point fault in this tournament! Non-qualifying F is called for an obstacle omitted.

Site Rules:

Please pick up after your dog. Poop bags are to be discarded in outside trash receptacles only. Do not let

your male dog lift its leg on the building, front landscaping, or on any item a human needs to handle.

These rules will be strictly enforced. .

The arena will close, and doors will be locked approximately one hour after the last run has been completed for the day. Be prepared.

Bitches in Season may not participate at this facility. If you are entered and your girl comes into season, please notify the trial secretary for credit. Even if it happens after closing, PMCC will take care of you, you're not SOL.

Other pertinent information follows:

Crating: There should be room for crating for everyone on the 'blacktop' inside the building.

Location: very convenient to US 206 / NJ-70 / various Turnpike exits, Southampton NJ 08088

Entry opens Friday January 20. OK to hand-deliver to secretary at an event or USPS mail to the Box 142, Morganville NJ 07751 address. No Fedex/UPS to this address; USPS has similar expedited services. Pre-Entry closes Tuesday Feb 21, after that, late/day of show entry prices.

Late / day of show entries accepted at \$75 International, \$45 Novice.

Equipment: The ring is filled with Clip & Go and Max 200 equipment.

Competition: **Jump heights** of 4,8,12,16, 20, 22, 24. Teeter and Dog walk have 36" contacts. Those in select/preferred don't get extra time. Enter your regular jump height (honor system). If a dog hasn't been measured before, measuring will be available.

There will be no table in any of the Novice courses. A-Frame height 5'6 except 5'3 for 4,8,12

EVENT TIMETABLE

Run Orders

Int'l Agility; Novice 1; Int'l Jumping; Novice 2; Int'l Jumps and Tunnels finals course. Number of International classes reduced from last year to make for a shorter day. Novice in a separate ring

Food: bring your own. There are several Wawa stores on NJ-70 and US 206 not far from the site..

Good Sportsmanship: Please treat others with kindness and respect.

Absolutely no aggressive behavior will be tolerated by a person or dog towards another. Any person or dog who is seen acting in an aggressive manner will be asked to leave and no refund will be given. If you have an issue with a person or dog, building, property, equipment, or parking lot, please see the Event Manager.

Music: may play during course builds and walk-throughs but not during any runs

Parking: plenty of room in the front lot. Inquire if you need handicap or RV parking.

Podiums: will be done at the end of each tournament, not after each round.

RESTROOM: Indoor restrooms towards front of building. Facility is heated.

RV and hotel information: most motels nearby are in Mount Holly, Mount Laurel, or Hammonton, close to NJ Turnpike. The motels closest-by on US-206 don't take dogs. Email sabledogs@icloud.com for RV info.

SCORING DETAILS for both the International Tournament and the Novice tournament:

Faults will be called as follows:

Knocked bar, missed contact, refusal/run-by - 5 faults

Missed weave pole entry or missed pole - 5 faults

Wrong course 15 faults

Omitted obstacle, repeat and move on aka Fix and Go = non-qualifying F.

NFC / FEO runs - you get course time but are ineligible for placement in that round

Fix and Go aka Repeat and Move On is allowed once per run.

Dogs that normally run in AKC Preferred or UKI Select will be scored with other dogs in the same height.

Seating: currently there are benches along the ring area. There may be room for seating near your crate.

Helpers: ring crew, timer/scribe/gate, and course builders are needed. Worker prizes will be awarded.

Workers don't have to be entered in either event.

Water for dogs from rest rooms, water for people is available for purchase.

Additional information will be in the final confirmation, which will be e-mailed after closing

Our asking shirt size doesn't guarantee that there will be shirts.
